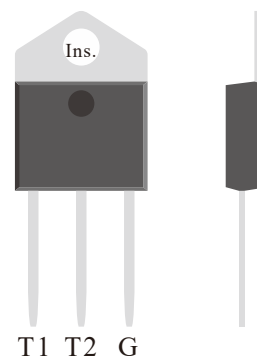

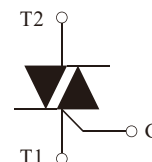

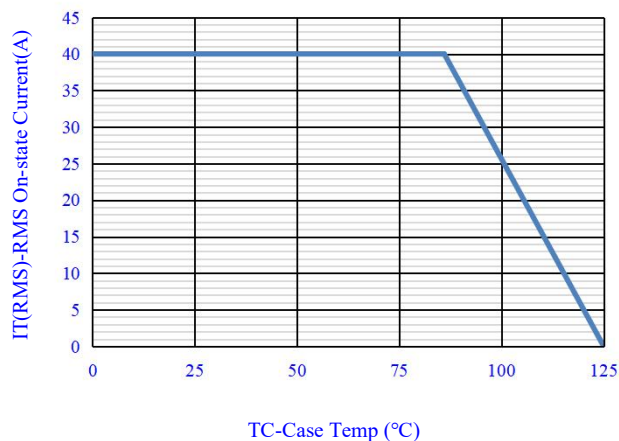


Fig.1-RMS on-state current vs. case temperature

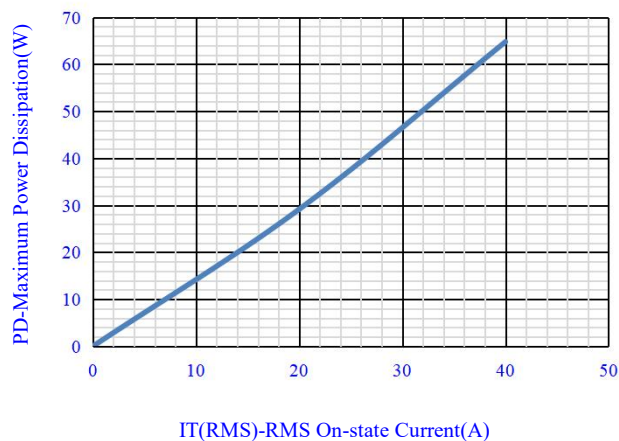


Fig.2- Maximum Power Dissipation Vs. on-state current

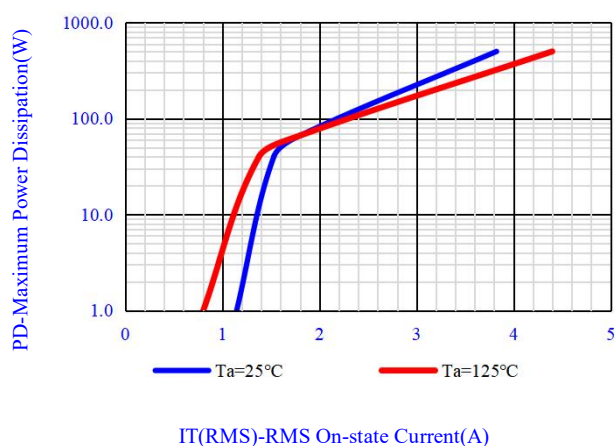


Fig.3- Maximum Power Dissipation Vs. on-state current

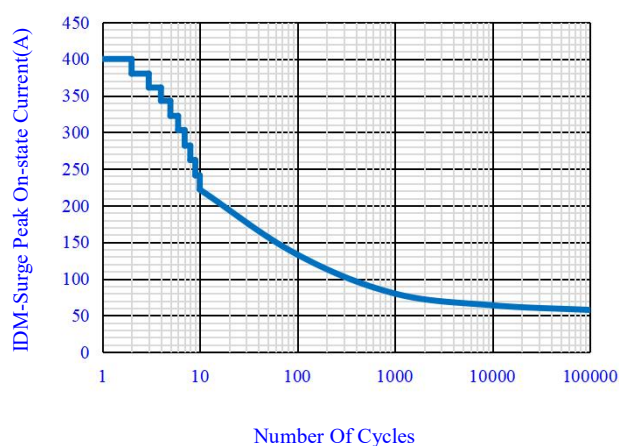


Fig.4- Surge Peak On-state Current Vs. Number Cycles

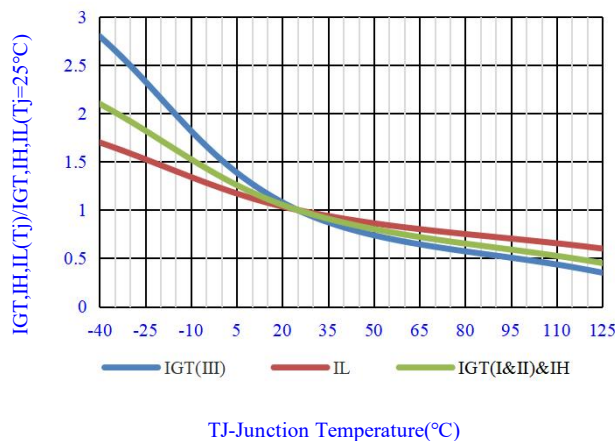


Fig.5- Relative Variation Of Gate Trigger Current, Holding Current And Latching Current Versus Junction Temperature (Typical Value)

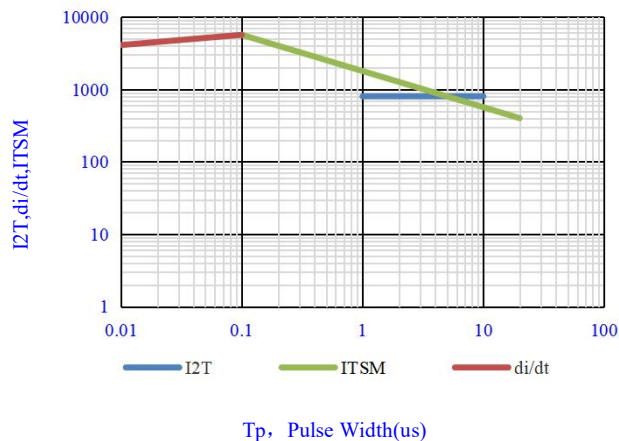
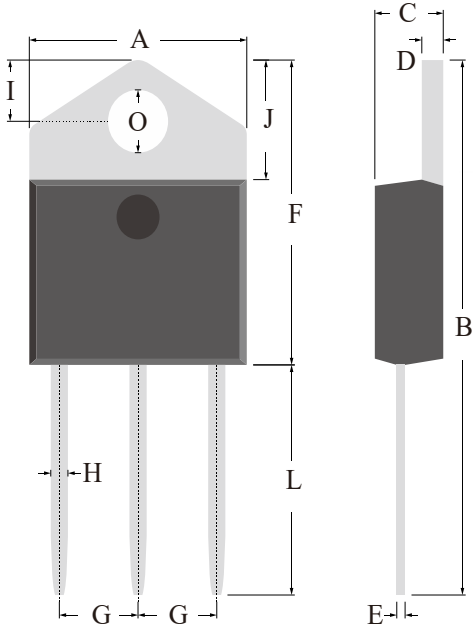


Fig.6- Non-repetitive surge peak on-state current for a sinusoidal pulse with width $t_p < 20\text{ms}$, and corresponding value of I_2t ($di/dt < 50\text{A}/\mu\text{s}$)

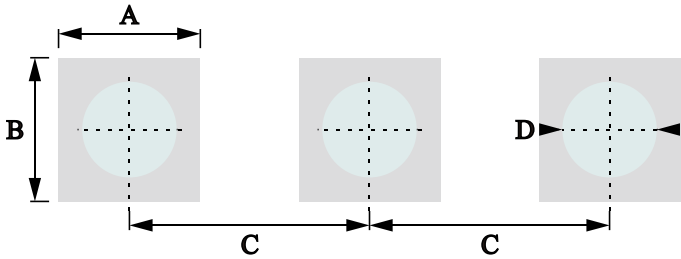

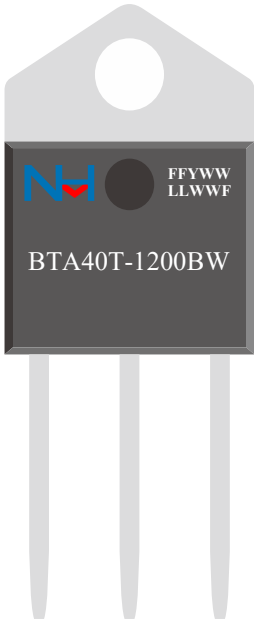

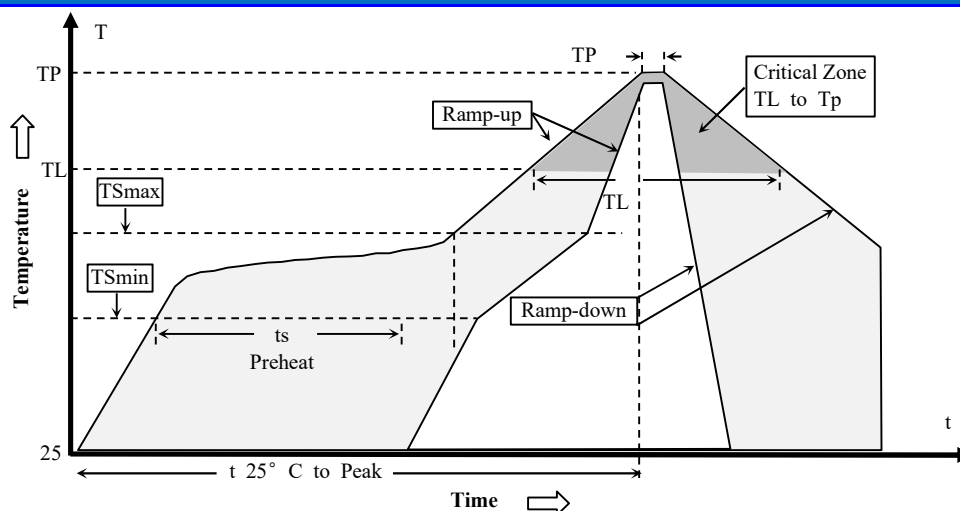
